INVOCATION

THE LITANY – LSB page 288 *ff.* (spoken)

HYMN – LSB #447 – “Jesus, in Your Dying Woes”, stanzas 1-3

FIRST READING – Luke 23:34

And Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do."
And they cast lots to divide his garments.

HYMN RESPONSE – LSB #447 – “Jesus, in Your Dying Woes”, stanzas 1-3

FIRST MEDITATION

(the first candle is extinguished)

SECOND READING – Luke 23:43

And [Jesus] said to him, "Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise."

HYMN RESPONSE – LSB #447 – “Jesus, in Your Dying Woes”, stanzas 4-6

SECOND MEDITATION

(the second candle is extinguished)

THIRD READING – John 19:26-27

When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to his mother, "Woman, behold, your son!" ²⁷ Then he said to the disciple, "Behold, your mother!" And from that hour the disciple took her to his own home.

HYMN RESPONSE – LSB #447 – “Jesus, in Your Dying Woes”, stanzas 7-9

THIRD MEDITATION

(the third candle is extinguished)

FOURTH READING – Matthew 27:46; Mark 15:34

And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" that is, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

And at the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, "Eloi, Eloi, lema sabachthani?" which means, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

HYMN RESPONSE – LSB #447 – “Jesus, in Your Dying Woes”, stanzas 10-12

FOURTH MEDITATION

(the fourth candle is extinguished)

FIFTH READING – John 19:28

After this, Jesus, knowing that all was now finished, said (to fulfill the Scripture), "I thirst."

HYMN RESPONSE – LSB #447 – “Jesus, in Your Dying Woes”, stanzas 13-15

FIFTH MEDITATION

(the fifth candle is extinguished)

SIXTH READING – John 19:30

When Jesus had received the sour wine, he said, "It is finished," and he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

HYMN RESPONSE – LSB #447 – “Jesus, in Your Dying Woes”, stanzas 16-18

SIXTH MEDITATION – “His Work is Over”

(the sixth candle is extinguished)

SEVENTH READING – Luke 23:46

Then Jesus, calling out with a loud voice, said, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!" And having said this he breathed his last.

HYMN RESPONSE – LSB #447 – “Jesus, in Your Dying Woes”, stanzas 19-21

SEVENTH MEDITATION

(the seventh candle is extinguished, leaving only the cross lit)

COLLECT OF THE DAY

THE STREIPTUS (LOUD NOISE)

(Worshippers leave in silence to respect Jesus’ death, and return on Saturday evening to celebrate His Resurrection at the Easter Vigil Service)
