(the second candle is extinguished)

# THIRD READING - John 19:26-27

When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to his mother, "Woman, behold, your son!" <sup>27</sup> Then he said to the disciple, "Behold, your mother!" And from that hour the disciple took her to his own home.

## FOURTH READING - Matthew 27:46; Mark 15:34

# SIXTH READING - John 19:30

When Jesus had received the sour wine, he said, "It is finished," and he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

HYMN RESPONSE – LSB #447 – "Jesus, in Your Dying Woes", stanzas 16-18

# SIXTH MEDITATION – "His Work is Over"

(the sixth candle is extinguished)

### SEVENTH READING – Luke 23:46

Then Jesus, calling out with a loud voice, said, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!" And having said this he breathed his last.

HYMN RESPONSE – LSB #447 – "Jesus, in Your Dying Woes", stanzas 19-21

### SEVENTH MEDITATION

(the seventh candle is extinguished, leaving only the cross lit)

### COLLECT OF THE DAY

THE STREIPTUS (LOUD NOISE)

(Worshippers leave in silence to respect Jesus' death, and return on Saturday evening to celebrate His Resurrection at the Easter Vigil Service)
